Preamble:

A proposal was submitted by Directorate of Primary Education vide reference No.3 to prescribe norms of pupil-teacher in primary school managed by District Education Committees and Municipal School Boards. Pupil-Teacher Ratio in primary school managed by District Education Committees and Municipal School Boards has been prescribed as under vide resolution referred on serial No.1 in reference :

Standard	90 % of the students registered As on 30 th September of concerned year	How many teachers can be appointed
Standard 1 and 2 (Total number of student in both the standard is to be considered)	up to 50. from 60 to 100 from 101 to 150 from 151 and accordingly one teacher shall be made available per each 50 students .	1 2 3 4
Standard 3 and 4 (Total numbers of students in both the standards are to be considered)	from 15 to 40 from 51 to 100 from 101 to 150 And accordingly one teacher shall be made available per each 50 students	1 2 3
Standard 5,6 and 7 Per each class	from 15 to 40 from 51 to 100 And accordingly one teacher shall be made available per each 50 students	1 2

Another teacher in a single –teacher school up to standard 3 and 4, will be made available when number of students increases more than 51.

Additional teachers (maximum three teachers) as under will be made available to the school which has 200 or more registered numbers of students.

No. of students	available additional teachers
From 200 to 500	1
From 501 to 1000	2
For more than 1000	3

State government has decided to implement Right to Education Act from dt.1/4/2010. Proposal made by Directorate of Education was under active consideration of government. After careful consideration, state government resolves Pupil-Teacher Ratio as under in primary school managed by District Education Committees and Municipal School Boards:

(A) Classes of std.1 to 5 :

1. Up to 60 students 2 teachers
2. From 61 to 90 students 3 teachers
3. From 91 to 120 students 4 teachers
4. From 121 to 200 students 5 teachers
5. Students above 200 -

Pupil Teacher Ratio must not exceed 40.

(B) Classes of 6 to 8 :

1. Minimum 3 teachers - one teacher for Mathematics-Science, one teacher for Languages and one teacher For Social science.
2. Minimum 1 teacher per each 35 students
