

**Ban on private tuition by Primary Teachers**

**Preface:-**

With a view to give free and compulsory education to all children, Government of India has endowed fundamental constitutional right to all children by passing 'The Right of Children to free and compulsory Education Act,2009' in parliament. There is a provision as under in Article-28 of the act:

"No teacher can do private tuition or activity of private education."

The matter of implementation of provisions of the article was under active consideration of Government. After careful consideration, it was resolved as under:

**Resolution:**

Government of India has imposed ban on teachers doing private tuition or activity of private education as per section 28 of 'The Right of Children to free and compulsory Education Act 2009 which is prescribed in preamble (1).i.e. Teachers/head masters of all primary schools can do no private tuition or any activity pertaining to it of any kind either by taking money or without taking money.

Teachers/Head Masters found violating the provision or about whom any presentation or complaint pertaining to it will be found and if it found to be true, disciplinary actions according to services and disciplinary rules will be taken against them.

The resolution shall be applicable to all primary schools of any medium i.e. Government schools, schools managed by District Education Committees and by Municipal school Boards, Aided private schools. Non-granted private schools, CBSE or ICSI or other school of any medium affiliated with any other board and is to be implemented by all teachers, head masters and managements.

The resolution is to be implemented from next academic year 2011-12 i.e. New academic terms starting from June, 2011.
